The Fulbright U.S. Student Grant can fully fund a year of research abroad for graduate students. U.S. citizens from all disciplines are eligible to apply, and grants are available to over 140 different countries. Detailed information is available at <https://us.fulbrightonline.org>.

The campus deadline for submitting an application is September 1, 2017. Complete applications are due to Jim Hohenbary, Fulbright Program Adviser, in 215 Fairchild by that date. Research applicants are commonly required to have identified a host country affiliation as part of the application process. Therefore, interested students are encouraged to speak with Mr. Hohenbary before the end of the Spring 2017 semester to learn more about the application process and discuss the process of securing an appropriate letter of affiliation.

Fulbright U.S. Student Grants are also available to serve as an English Teaching Assistant in many countries.
