



Grants to Reach Underserved Student Populations to Study Abroad

Take advantage of this open competition, sponsored by the MetLife Foundation, to increase study abroad between the US, Mexico and South America. The purpose of this competition is to provide incentive grants to higher education institutions (HEIs) in eligible countries to promote study abroad and training opportunities in any field of study, so long as it focuses in targeting students of diverse backgrounds.

Eligibility: All HEIs in the United States, Argentina, Chile, Colombia, and Mexico are eligible for this competition.

Fields: Proposals may include any academic field of study, so long as it includes a special emphasis on programs that diversify the student population studying abroad, specifically those of racial ethnic or economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

Available Awards: This competition will award 8 grants of up to USD \$25,000 each to selected proposals.

The deadline to submit a proposal is August 31, 2017
