

Career Opportunities in Biostatistics and Statistical Consulting/Collaboration

Thanks to the fact that the US has an advanced, post-industrialized, service-oriented economy, health care and research has become a very important component of industry as well as government-driven research and service. Biostatistics plays a critical role as research methodology in many areas of biomedical health research.
