

INTERNATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE

Faculty-Led Group Study Abroad Kansas State University

All program participants are required to enroll in an international medical insurance policy. Students and faculty leaders, who are participating in K-State faculty-led group study abroad programs, will automatically be enrolled in an international medical insurance policy by the Coordinator of Faculty Services. Generally, if students wish to travel independently before or after the official program travel dates, they have an option to extend their international health insurance policy. They can do this by contacting Rose Redington, Coordinator of Faculty Services (rosered@ksu.edu / 785-532-5990).

In foreign countries, most doctors and hospitals do not recognize U.S. insurance for automatic billing. In most cases student participants will need to pay at the time of medical treatment and submit a claim for reimbursement. For this reason all students are instructed to carry emergency funding, preferably in the form of a credit or ATM card. It is important to keep all medical receipts as these will be required for reimbursement from the insurance provider.
