PROGRAM

CS 825: International Veterinary Study Tour will provide Vet Med students with the unique opportunity to explore veterinary medicine in Belgium and the Netherlands. Students will learn about the countries through lectures, research, and presentations prior to traveling. Throughout the duration of the study tour, students will interact with locals to gain exposure to the culture and to the veterinary profession.

FACULTY LEADER

Dr. Walter Renberg, Associate Professor in the College of Veterinary Medicine, specializes in small animal surgery. He is the chair of the CVM International Activities Committee and has traveled to over 30 countries. He grew up in Belgium and has led student groups to a number of countries across the world.

DATES

Course Dates: January 14 – April 30, 2010

Travel Dates: March 12 – 22, 2010

ELIGIBILITY

Enrollment in the College of Veterinary Medicine is required. Additional students may be admitted with the discretion of the Faculty Leader.

CREDIT

Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive 3 hours of graduate credit for CS 825: International Veterinary Study Tour.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit the University of Liege and the University of Ghent Veterinary Schools and the Veterinary School at the University of Utrecht
- Visit private veterinary practices as well as horse and cattle farms
- Visit historic sites such as the Grand Place, a castle, Bruges, and the European Union headquarters
- Experience the history and culture of Holland in and around Amsterdam including a windmill tour, a dyke, the Anne Franck museum, and others.



COST

- **Program Fees** collected by the Office of International Programs: \$2,526.00 (*includes airfare, accommodations, in-country transportation, K-State study abroad administration fee, program provider fees, and international health insurance.*)
- **Anticipated Additional Expenses:** \$822.00 (for expenses such as passport fee, individual meals, optional international student ID card, and admissions to events/tours).
- **Estimated K-State Tuition and Fees:** \$1,271.50 for 3 credit hours and \$21.50 Division of Continuing Education Fee
