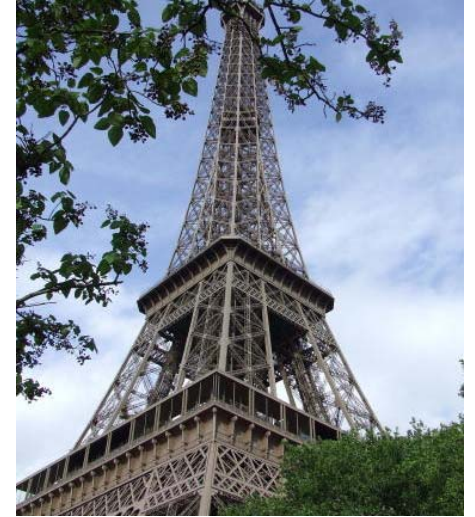

PROGRAM

K-State in Paris is a program which focuses on French Language and Culture. The program is designed for Beginning, Intermediate and Advanced level students. Students will experience many of the cultural wonders of France by participating in various cultural activities and excursions. Students will live with French host families in an effort to maximize their language and cultural understanding.

FACULTY LEADER

Dr. Clark joined the Department of Modern Languages in 1992 and has led the summer program in France for five successive summers. He has resided in Paris for a total of eight years and has published on medieval Paris.

ELIGIBILITY

Minimum 2.5 GPA

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

This program will provide students with up to 8 academic credits: two French courses from the Catholic University of Paris (5 transfer credits) and a Cultural History of Paris course (3 KSU credits) taught by Dr. Clark.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Live with French host family in Paris
- Multiple excursions and guided tours in Normandy, Paris, Versailles, Mont. St. Michel, and Loire Valley
- French language immersion



COST

Program Fees: \$5,258 (includes accommodation with French host family, breakfast and dinner daily, tutorial assistance, laundry service, some in-country transportation, cultural excursions, entrance fees, guided tours, French university's tuition and fees, KSU study abroad fee, and international medical insurance)

Anticipated Additional Expenses: \$2,540 (for expenses such as passport, textbook, lunch daily, meals on excursions, international airfare, metro pass, phone charges, transportation to/from U.S. point of departure, and personal expenses)

Tuition and Fees: Estimated tuition and fees for one 3-credit KSU undergraduate course is \$618.60. Division of Continuing Education (DCE) Fee: \$21.50
