Study Tour in
Indonesia
Bali, Flories, and Wallacea:
An Evolutionary Oddity



PROGRAM

Students will explore the unique features of Wallacea by visiting and exploring several islands in the region during a 10-day trip. In addition to visits to various National Parks, three lectures will be provided as follows: 1. The geological history of the islands. 2. The faunal and floral composition of Wallacea and its significance. 3. Conservation of flora and fauna in Wallacea. Overall, the students will be exposed to a number of habitats, plants, and animals. Equally exciting is the visit to Flores Island on which skeletal remains of a previously unknown hominid species (*Homo floresensis*) were recently discovered. Students will observe the transitions in marine life during snorkeling around the islands, in addition to visiting volcano bases during the trips to various National Parks.

FACULTY LEADER

Dr. Srinii Kambhampati is a professor of genetics and evolution in the Kansas State University Department of Entomology. He has traveled extensively internationally for field work, research, and professional conferences. He has led two study abroad courses to the Galapagos in 2005 and 2007. He has traveled to Indonesia twice (2006, 2009) to assess the logistics of teaching this study abroad course on biogeography.

CREDIT

Upon successful completion of the course, students will be awarded 2 hours undergraduate or graduate credit for ENTOM 599

ELIGIBILITY

Minimum 2.5 GPA

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit several national parks
- Visit Flores Island
- Participate in a 3 day culture study in Bali
- Observe the transitions in marine life while snorkeling around the islands, as well as visit various volcanic regions

COST

Program Fees: \$3,500 (*includes: international airfare, in-country transportation, accommodations, K-State study abroad administration fee, cultural activities and admissions, group meals, contingency fees, gratuities, country-specific visa fee, and international medical insurance*)

Anticipated Additional Expenses: Approximately \$320.00 (*for fees such as passport fee, individual meals, textbook, transportation to/from U.S. point of departure, and phone charges*)

Estimated K-State Tuition and Fees: Estimated K-State tuition for 2 undergraduate credit hours is \$412.40. Estimated K-State tuition for 2 graduate credit hours is \$559.80. Division of Continuing Education (DCE) fee: \$21.50.
