South Korea
Interior Design Study Tour



PROGRAM

This will be a two week intensive course on interior design in South Korea. Students will gain extensive exposure to a non-western culture; learn to appreciate diverse cultures and their material artifacts; and examine historic and contemporary architecture, interiors and furnishings of Korea.

FACULTY LEADER

Professor Kim received his Master of Fine Arts and Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Design from the College of Design at Iowa State University. Professor Kim's current focus is "Sustainable Design through Virtual Reality". His studies explore the results of an experimental class curriculum where interior design educators teach sustainability and computer technology in a design studio focusing on contemporary environmental issues. Professor Kim was born in South Korea and is an expert on Asian Interior Design.

CREDIT

Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive 3 hours of K-State undergraduate credit for ID600: Interior Design Study Tour Korea.

ELIGIBILITY

Minimum 2.5 GPA and instructor permission

COST

Program Fees: \$4,340 *(Includes international airfare, accommodations, in-country transportation, K-State Study Abroad Fee, group meals, program provider fees, contingency fees, and international health insurance.)*

Anticipated Additional Expenses: \$433 *(for expenses such as passport, individual meals, transportation to/from U.S. point of departure, transportation in Seoul, and gratuities/tips)*

Estimated K-State Tuition and Fees: \$618.60 for 3 credit hours and \$21.50 Division of Continuing Education Fee
