Equine Study Tour

Spain, Portugal, and Morocco



PROGRAM

This program is a 16-day intensive Animal Science study tour through Spain, Portugal, and Morocco. Main areas of focus include production and management practices, major breeds and uses, and educational opportunities. There will also be trips to riding schools, equine breeding and training operations, and support and discipline-based facilities. Students will also become familiar with the history and cultures of these three countries.

FACULTY LEADER

Dr. Joann Kouba is an Associate Professor in the Department of Animal Science and Industry. In 2001, she joined K-State and now teaches a number of equine courses, which include various production, management and training courses.

CREDIT

Upon successful completion of the course, students will be awarded 3 hours of undergraduate or graduate credit for ASI 660.
