PROGRAM

This course will focus on Machiavelli and the Foundations of Modern Political Philosophy. Topics which will be explored include: politics and human nature, power and the art of politics, forms of governance and the ends of political life. Several other course options will also be available.

COST

Program Fees: \$2,730 (includes: in-country transportation, accommodations, K-State study abroad administration fee, tours, and international medical insurance)

Anticipated Additional Expenses: Approximately \$2,200 (international airfare, textbooks, meals, optional tours, optional international cell phone and SIM card)

Estimated K-State Tuition and Fees: Estimated K-State tuition for one 3-credit undergraduate course is \$618.60. Division of Continuing Education (DCE) fee: \$21.50.
