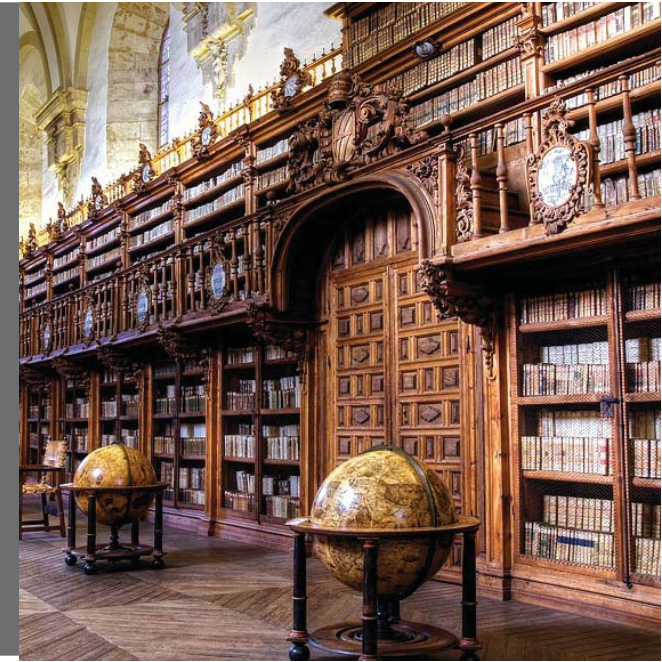

Spain
Spanish Language and
Culture Study



PROGRAM

This course is an exploration of the most important periods of Spanish history through visits, on-site classes and daily living in a context of immersion in the Spanish culture. The course will cover significant places and sites of all periods, emphasizing art from the Paleolithic period to contemporary Spain. Students will gain an understanding of the Iberian Peninsula and its role in being a crossroad in the formation of various cultures.

DATES

Travel Dates: May 31 – July 7, 2010

After March 15, 2010, mandatory group meetings will be held periodically on the KSU campus to prepare students for the program.

FACULTY LEADER

Dr. Benjamin Torrico teaches a broad variety of language, literature and culture classes in the Department of Modern Languages at K-State, with a specialty in medieval and baroque literature. He has led student groups to Spain on numerous occasions with K-State as well as other institutions.

CREDIT

Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive 3 undergraduate K-State credits and 6 transfer credits from the University of Salamanca.

ELIGIBILITY

Minimum 2.5 GPA and instructor permission required

Pre-Requisite: Spanish 4 or instructor permission

COST

Program Fees: Approximately \$4,444 (*includes accommodations, in-country transportation, K-State study abroad administration fee, program provider fees, international health insurance, books, meals, and tuition at the University of Salamanca*)

Anticipated Additional Expenses: \$1,542 (*for expenses such as international airfare, passport fee, phone charges*)

Estimated K-State Tuition and Fees: \$618.60 for 3 K-State undergraduate credit hours. \$21.50 Division of Continuing Education Fee
