Exchange Programs

Nagasaki University of Foreign Studies in Nagasaki <http://www.nagasaki-gaiigo.ac.jp/ncs/jasin>

The Japanese Studies in Nagasaki (JASIN) is not an intensive language program, instead the curriculum is designed to give students a wide academic experience in a variety of aspects of Japanese society and culture. Some classes offered are Japanese as a second language, Japanese Business and Japanese Art.

Toyo University is located in central Tokyo and is for students with at least one year of Japanese language.
