INPL Summer Program in Nancy, France

Nancy is located 200 miles east of Paris and has about 30,000 people. The Institut National Polytechnique de Lorraine (INPL) is a public university of technology with 40,000 students. Summer Program is a two-month program running each year from mid-May to mid-July, which offers a real opportunity to discover the INPL, France’s largest technological university located in the heart of western Europe, and to explore possible opportunities for a longer stay in France.

Through KSU’s membership in an organization called MAUI (Mid-America Universities International), students have the opportunity to pay tuition and fees to K-State and housing and board to a host university in Europe. Many of these universities offer a number of classes in English.

In the Food Science and Nutrition program Deakin produces graduates that go in to government food laboratories, food wholesale and retail industries, government entities in health, nutrition and agribusiness, research institutes, product marketing and food quality assurance.
