Vaxjo, with 70,000 inhabitants, is 125 miles northwest of Copenhagen and 250 miles southwest of Stockholm. It is a charming city with forests, lakes, fountains and a 700-year-old castle. Vaxjo University has over 450 international students and is known for its global approach to education and many programs are taught in English for both Swedish and international students. Engineers may be interested in their Computer Science program and classes like Data Security, Software Engineering and Algorithm Theory. This is a K-State tuition, fees, room and board exchange.
