

Enroll for the K-State MLANG Study Abroad Placeholder Course

Summer/Semester/All Year Programs

WHY?

- In order to get credit for your study abroad experience you will need to enroll in the MLANG Study Abroad Placeholder Course.
- The MLANG Study Abroad Placeholder Course makes you eligible for Financial Aid.
- The course keeps your student status active at K-State.
- The course enables you to use your K-State e-mail while you are abroad.
- The course allows you to access iSIS while you are abroad.
- The course ensures that your study abroad experience will be included on your K-State transcripts.
- The course signals to the K-State Cashiers Office that you will be studying abroad.

WHICH PROGRAMS NEED TO ENROLL?

- Summer/Semester/All Year Programs: Students need to enroll in MLANG 001.

WHEN DO I ENROLL IN THE COURSE?

- Summer/Semester/Year Programs: Both the K-State Study Abroad Program and your K-State academic advisor need to lift the flag of approval for you to be able to enroll in the MLANG Study Abroad Placeholder Course. You will receive an e-mail from the Study Abroad Program notifying you when it is time to enroll in the course. The e-mail will also inform you on how to enroll and will give you the name and reference number of the course. When you receive the e-mail saying that you can enroll in the course, please do so immediately.
- If you do not enroll in the MLANG Study Abroad Placeholder Course, you will not get credit for your Study Abroad experience at K-State.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- Summer/Semester/Year Programs: Fee is \$25.

HOW MANY CREDITS DO I ENROLL FOR?

- Summer Programs: You may enroll in 6 credits.
- Semester/Year Programs: You may enroll in 12 credits for every semester you are abroad.

ARE THERE ANY OTHER COURSES THAT I WILL NEED TO ENROLL IN?

- Honors Society: Be sure to contact the University Honors Program
- Business Students: Be sure to connect with your academic advisor about the Business Study Abroad course that you will need to enroll in as well.
