

Flint Hills National Golf Club is located just outside Wichita in Andover, Kansas. Built by Tom Devlin in 1996 and designed by the nation's top architect Tom Fazio, the course covers 240 acres with an average green size of 6,975 feet, contains 67 bunkers, and a 32 acre practice facility with nine bentgrass target greens. Flint Hills contains approximately 5,700 planted trees and 70 different varieties, which is looked over by our very own arborist. The course consists of bentgrass greens, zoysia fairways/tees, and bluegrass rough with a blend of native grasses.

- Maintain a cooperative, team-like attitude in working with supervisors and fellow teammates (both within our department and other departments within our club), to help achieve our common goals of maximizing member satisfaction
- Calculate with proficiency common equations regularly used with golf course maintenance
- Assist our technician in daily equipment maintenance and inspections
- Properly mix and apply all pesticides with various sprayer equipment
- Calibrate sprayers and spreaders commonly used on golf courses
