Description

Sand Valley Golf Resort is situated on over 1700 acres of sand dunes in central Wisconsin. The first course, a Coore & Crenshaw design, will have its grand opening in May of 2017. The second course, designed by David Mclay Kidd, will be completed during the 2017 season.

Interns will have involvement in both; preparing the completed holes for opening and fescue and bentgrass maintenance, and assisting with the construction, seeding and finishing processes.

Interns will be involved in, but not limited to the following activities:

- Finish work including; seeding greens, tees, fairways, native areas using various techniques including hydro mulching, seed bed preparation
- Drainage projects
- Bunker construction
- HDPE irrigation installation
- Sod projects
- Fertilizer/pesticide application, calibration and record keeping
- Manage crews of up to 15 employees for various projects
- Turfgrass cultural practices (mowing, verticutting, topdressing, aerifying, rolling, ect.)

- Willing to work as part of a team in an organized, high-paced environment
