STUDY ABROAD PROPOSAL

Betsy Cauble and Susanne Siepl-Coates had updated their proposal to address the questions posed at the previous meeting and in light of discussions on the UGE Council. They changed the proposal's waiver of UGE requirements to meeting UGE credit-hour requirements. When study abroad credit is accepted at Kansas State, the student will have met a portion or all of their UGE requirements at the 300 level or above, based on the number of credit hours accepted. DARS will record this number of UGE credit-hours as having been met. For students who studied abroad in past semesters, their UGE requirements will be handled on a case-by-case basis. The Panel voted to accept the proposal as written with an 8-1 vote.
