MEETING MINUTES

21 April 2000

DISCUSSION OF MINUTES

A change to the March 17, 2000, minutes will reflect the flexibility that departments will have by *supporting* graduate assistants, rather than having graduate assistants do the UGE coursework. The minutes were accepted as amended.

UGE COURSE LISTINGS

Elsea distributed an email that had been sent to him by Dr. Clegg. The email described an announcement that the Registrar's Office is intending to maintain one official UGE course list that will contain all information that is necessary or helpful pertaining to UGE courses. The new list is expected to be added during the summer of 2000.

UPPER-DIVISION UGE COURSES

Also on Clegg's email was some of the feedback on courses the colleges would like to see developed as upper-division courses. She will be visiting closely with department heads and Reeck, since many of the areas are from the College of Arts & Sciences, in order to determine which upper-division courses may be developed for UGE. There has been some good discussion about which courses would be good candidates for UGE, and after Clegg gets feedback from department heads, a more detailed proposal may be developed.

UPDATE ON PHASE II ASSESSMENT TEAM (P2)

The ICCP has been part of the discussion by the Phase II Assessment Team in their development of a proposal for assessing UGE processes. ICCP members may be called upon for assisting in advisors' surveys, enrollment and UGE course availability in colleges' UGE programs and transfer-credit policies.
