As Vice President for Research, serves as the chief research officer at Kansas State University with responsibility for research administration and research compliance matters campus-wide.

**PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE**

As President of the Kansas State University Research Foundation from 1995 to 2011, facilitated the patenting and commercialization of intellectual property derived from university research.

As the Dean of Kansas State's Graduate School from 1998 to 2007, provided oversight and administrative services for all university master's and doctoral degree programs.

At Ohio State University, conducted cancer research in the Comprehensive Cancer Center and taught biochemistry as a faculty member in the College of Medicine from 1978 to 1994.

- ❖ Awarded 15 competitive extramural grants totaling \$3.5 million, with 11 of those as principal investigator, 3 as co-principal investigator, and 1 as program director.
- ❖ Directed the Ohio State Biochemistry Program, the university's largest interdisciplinary graduate program with over 80 faculty members from 6 colleges and 16 departments.
- ❖ Directed the Comprehensive Cancer Center's tumor procurement service, assessed by the National Cancer Institute as the most cost effective program of its type in the country.
