Group FAQ

Here are some frequently asked questions about the Sexual Assault Survivor Trauma Recovery Group. If you have questions not on this list, please call the K-State Women's Center at (785) 532-6444 or Counseling Services 532-6927.

Q: When does the Group meet?

A: The Group meets on Tuesdays at 5:00-6:30.

Q: Where does the Group meet?

A: The Support Group will meet in the English/Counseling Services building, room 232.

Q: Where can I park?

A: The area right behind the counseling services building is available for student parking, as it is after hours. Students may also utilize Wildcat Walk and be escorted to and from the group by calling 395-SAFE (395-7233).

Q: Do I need to sign up or let some one know that I am coming?

A: Yes. To register for the group, please contact Counseling Services at 532-6927 and ask to speak with Barb Pearson about the Trauma Recovery Group.

Q: Is this group only for sexual assault survivors? For incest/childhood abuse survivors?

A: This group is for anyone who has been affected by sexual violence, including survivors of both sexual assault and incest/childhood abuse.

Q: Is this support group only for college students?

A: Currently, the fees are being paid for by the K-State Women's Center, so it is an option for college students only.
