## 2 Navigate to the Program Budget Sheet

Every direct enroll program will have a program brochure that includes information about the program. In the "Program Costs" tab, there will be a budget sheet with the estimated costs of the program.

# 3 Review the Program Budget

Direct enroll program budgets are split into two sections: billable expenses and non-billable expenses. Billable expenses are expenses that are billed to KSIS. Non-billable expenses are expenses that are paid out of pocket. All tuition and fees paid for a direct enroll program are based on the rates of the host university. In some countries, these fees may be lower than K-State and sometimes they are higher.

**Billable Subtotal:** This is the amount that would be billed to your KSIS account at a date determined by the term that you go abroad. The enrollment fee and admin fee are fixed, but the insurance rate is billed at a weekly rate and varies by program length.

- Fall programs (early August)
- Spring programs (early January)
- Summer programs (mid-May)

**Non-Billable Subtotal:** These are an estimate of other out of pocket expenses. Some out of pocket expenses will need to be paid ahead of time (such as passport or airfare) while most are paid once you are in country (such as meals or personal expenses). Check the fee information for the specific program to see when payments are due to the university for accomodation and tuition.
