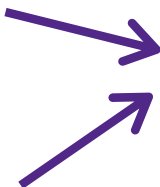

# 3 Review the Program Budget

Exchange program budgets are split into two sections: billable expenses and non-billable expenses. Billable expenses are expenses that are billed to KSIS. Non-billable expenses are expenses that are paid out of pocket. There are two types of exchanges Tuition & Fees (T/F) and Tuition, Fees, Room & Board (T/F/R/B). Depending on the type of exchange tuition and fees (room and board) will be billed to KSIS.

**Exchange Tuition:** All students will pay an exchange tuition fee which is calculated based on 15 credit hours at the K-State in-state rate.



**Exchange Room & Board:** All students will pay a housing fee which is calculated based on rates of on campus housing, break housing and meal plan at K-State.

**Billable Subtotal:** This is the amount that would be billed to your KSIS account at a date determined by the term you go abroad.  
 -Fall programs (early August)  
 -Spring programs (early January)  
 -Summer programs (mid-May)
