

FINANCIAL ESTIMATE INFORMATION FOR EXCHANGE APPLICANTS

Admitted students who request an F-1 or J-1 non-immigrant status must provide financial documentation (dated within 1 year) to prove that the student has sufficient funding to cover his/her expenses equal or greater than the estimated yearly cost for an I-20 or estimated cost for the entire period of study for a DS-2019.

The Affidavit of Support form is required if the account holder listed on the bank document is not the student.

COST OF ATTENDANCE

Financial estimates of expenses covered under the exchange agreement are shown below. These estimated expenses are subject to change and are updated annually based on cost of living and tuition increases.

Students will need to provide support documentation to cover remaining estimated expenses noted in the last column of the chart. Cost of attendance estimates are based on tuition and fees for 15 credit hours per semester.
