Study Abroad (Semester)

Hirakata City, Japan

Exchange program: Kansai Gaidai University

About: The Asian Studies Program at Kansai Gaidai University allows students to study midway between the ancient capital of Koto and the dynamic business center of Osaka. Past course offerings have included East Asian Literature & Culture in Translation; Kojiki to Haruki: Literary Representations of Diverse Eras; and Kodai to Gendai: Influences of Literature on Japanese Society & Culture.

Mendoza, Argentina

API Program: Universidad de Congreso

About: Ideal for students also interested in Spanish language, this program offers the opportunity to take classes with local Argentine students as well as classes in English. Past courses have included Creative Writing in Mendoza and Argentine Fiction, as well as other academic areas. Students can trek the nearby Andes Mountains, tour local wineries, and more!

Sydney, Australia

Exchange program: University of Sydney

About: The University of Sydney, founded in 1850, has built an international reputation for its outstanding teaching and as a center for research excellence. While the area is surrounded by trendy shops and cafés and is only 20 minutes from the ocean, graceful historic buildings and gardens create an atmosphere of tradition on the campus.

Växjö, Sweden

USAC Program: Linnaeus University

About: Växjö is the capital of the Kronoberg region in Sweden, and the surrounding area boasts forests, pristine lakes, and hiking trails. Students can take classes in English in a variety of fields including English, film studies, history, and journalism. You can even add a Swedish language course to your studies!



Study Abroad (Summer)

Orvieto, Italy

Kansas State University in Italy

About: Located in the Italian hill town of Orvieto, and centrally located between Rome and Florence, with both cities just a short train ride away. This is KSU's premiere summer study abroad program in Italy and is open to all students and majors. Students will study with KSU faculty members at the Centro Studi Citta di Orvieto and earn KSU credit.

Lyon, France

<u>USAC Program: Lyon Catholic University</u>

About: This program hosted at L'Université Catholique de Lyon lies in the heart of Lyon. The city is a train ride away from Paris, Provence, the French Alps, and more. Past courses have included Travel Writing and the Art of Being French, Francophone Women Writers, and LGBTQ+ France: Cultural and Literary Perspectives.

International Service Teams

About: International Teams is a service-learning program of interdisciplinary teams of Kansas State University students. Teams travel and live in communities around the world during the summer break.
