Recommended Program

Pau, France

USAC Program: University of Pau

About: The University of Pau is a green campus with excellent student services and numerous opportunities to meet local students and get involved in campus activities. Set against the backdrop of the Pyrenees Mountains, students have access to beautiful nature and outdoor activities, as well as the Basque wine country. Pau is lively city with spectacular promenades for shopping, people watching, and eating out. Housing options include student apartments or home stays with Paulois families. Semester and summer options available for intensive French study.

Study Abroad (Semester)

Lyon, France

USAC Program: L'Université Catholique de Lyon

About: Lyon is considered one of the most beautiful cities in France, and is host to cultural events including "Nuits Sonores", "Fête des Lumières", Cinema festivals, and more. In 1998 it was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Students can earn up to 12 credit hours of French language along with electives and French Studies courses. USAC activities include field trips to Geneva, the Beaujolais region, and the French Alps.

Aix-en-Provence, France

IAU Program: University of Aix-Marseille

About: The Institute for American Universities (IAU) France program allows students to study in the old section of Aixen-Provence and is the only study abroad center in the region. Choose from classes taught in either French or English. The School of Humanities and Social Sciences focuses on French language learning that includes acquiring knowledge of distinctive characteristics of the arts and cultures of France.

Paris, France

ISA Program: The American Business School Paris

About: ABSP is a program that specializes in business, brand management, and French language courses. Studying here will be your first steps towards an international career in one of the most dynamic cities in the world, Paris. This program includes participation in an internship in the fields of marketing, finance, or fashion. Students who are looking for an interdisciplinary experience in business and French language should take advantage of this opportunity!



Study Abroad (Summer)

Grenoble, France

API Program: Université Grenoble Alpes

About: At the foot of the French Alps, Grenoble is a mountain town perfect for studying French language and culture. Students will take one French language course and two elective courses during the program. Excursions are included in the program fees, with possible locations such as Lyon, Marseille, Paris, Chartreuse, and Geneva, Switzerland.

Lille, France

API Program: Université Catholique de Lille

About: Université Catholique de Lille is a prestigious, private university in the French education system; however, courses, extracurricular activities, and campus life are secular in nature. Classes are offered in both French and English. Examples of past courses taught in French include Language and Culture, Understanding the Challenges of Climate Change, French Communication, and Franco-Belgian Cinema.

Paris, France

ISA Program: Institut Catholique de Paris

About: This program offers intensive French language instruction for all levels in an immersive setting, with Paris as the backdrop of your studies! Take courses about French grammar, phonetics, cinema, feminism, art, and more! Students have the option to live with a host family or in shared apartments or dormitories.
