Study Abroad (Semester)

Hatfield, United Kingdom

Exchange Program: University of Hertfordshire

About: An hour from London, the University of Hertfordshire gives you the best of both worlds. You'll live in an active university town with pubs, cinemas, and shopping centers but have easy access to the bustle of London. Hertfordshire's Life and Medical Sciences program includes classes like Brain Disorders, Psychology of Performing Arts, People and Society, and Schools of Psychotherapy

Melbourne, Australia

Exchange Program: Deakin University

About: Deakin University offers a complimentary curriculum to K-State, making it a good fit for most majors. Melbourne is rated one of the world's most livable cities, with easy access to beaches and many of the country's cultural institutions.

Nakhonpathom, Thailand

TEAN Program: Mahidol University International College

About: One of the best universities in Thailand and all of Southeast Asia, MUIC offers courses in nearly all fields. Study psychology, sociology, history, and more at this serene campus only 30 minutes from the bustle of modern Bangkok.

Study Abroad (Summer)

Orvieto, Italy

Kansas State University in Italy

About: Located in the Italian hill town of Orvieto, and centrally located between Rome and Florence, with both cities just a short train ride away. This is KSU's premiere summer study abroad program in Italy and is open to all students and majors. Students will study with KSU faculty members at the Centro Studi Citta di Orvieto and earn KSU credit.

Prague, Czech Republic

Direct Enroll: Charles University, East Central European Studies Program

About: Study at one Europe's oldest universities in the heart of Europe. Students can spend a summer or semester with ECES and take classes in arts, humanities, and social science. The ECES program is set aside specifically for international students at Charles University in Prague.

Research Abroad (Summer)

Liverpool, United Kingdom

Direct Enroll: University of Liverpool

About: Spend your summer at the University of Liverpool alongside university researchers and faculty. Past summer research projects have included fields like environmental science, psychology, life science, and computer science. While completing the research project, you will have access to libraries, the fitness center, accommodation, and other university services.
