Study Abroad (Semester)

Hirakata City, Japan

[Exchange Program: Kansai Gaidai University](#)

About: Hirakata City is located in the Osaka region, which is the second largest business metropolis in Japan. Kansai Gaidai welcomes about 700 international students from all over the world each year. In addition to language classes for all levels, students take courses in English across History, Sociology, Anthropology, Political Science, and Gender Studies courses.
