Recommended Programs

Belfast and Derry, Northern Ireland, United Kingdom

Faculty Led: Peace and Conflict in Northern Ireland

About: This course study will examine the historical, political, and religious roots of Northern Ireland's conflict. The focus of study also will include an analysis of the area's traditions and exploration into the ways in which this divided society copes with the attendant political, economic, and social problems. Prospects for continued and sustainable peace in this region, as well as how progress is being made, also will be examined.

Asuncion, Paraguay

Faculty Led: Problems in Early Care and Education in Paraguay

About: This course is designed to give students the opportunity to explore the history of the country, cultural, economic, and educational issues affecting young children in Paraguay. Study tour components will include a visit to the U.S. Embassy, observation and teaching in early childhood classrooms in a variety of public and private Paraguayan schools, collaboration with students from the National University of Paraguay/Instituto Superior de Educacion, visiting surrounding areas near Asuncion, and exploration of the culture of Paraguay.
