## Study Abroad (Semester)

### Liverpool, United Kingdom

*Exchange program: University of Liverpool*

**Great for:** Law and International Politics

**About:** Rated in the top 1% of universities in the world, Liverpool offers courses in a comprehensive selection of fields, including International Economics, Business, Law, and Political Philosophy

### Kraków, Poland

*USAC Program: Cracow University of Economics*

**Great for:** Economics, Political Science, and History

**About:** As the country's former capital, the charming city of Kraków remains one of the most culturally and politically significant places in the country. The historic town center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the city has a significant role in the history of World War II. The city hosts over 100 festivals annually, offers an affordable cost of living, and provides easy access to outdoor activities like hiking or skiing.

### Hirakata City, Japan

*Exchange program: Kansai Gaidai University*

**Great for:** Asian Studies, Art, Political Science

**About:** Hirakata City is located in the Osaka region, which is the second largest business metropolis in Japan. In addition to language classes for all levels, students at KGU have access to a broad course catalog and can take courses addressing Asian studies, history, economics, political science, sociology, and more.

### Dubrovnik, Croatia

*API program: Diplomacy and International Business*

**Great for:** International Relations, Business, and Diplomacy

**About:** Students study at Libertas International University in the picturesque city of Dubrovnik. Courses are taught by professors who also working diplomats or business leaders

### Prague, Czech Republic

**Scholarship options:** Admitted student can apply for the ECES Cultural Immersion Scholarship

**About:** Study at one of Central Europe's oldest universities. This is also one of the most affordable options. Summer and semester options available.

## Research Abroad (Summer)

### Sydney, Australia

**About:** The Study Abroad Research Practicum is designed for students to undertake short term research visits to UNSW, one of Australia's leading research universities. Through SARP, students at any level of study can visit UNSW for up to 12 months for research purposes. There is no minimum stay required, however students should have a minimum 3.0 GPA. This is a research-only program.
