The 5-year professional program is available to students who wish to earn their Master of Science in athletic training degree from K-State. Students will enroll at K-State as an undergraduate student in the athletic training and rehabilitation sciences program. During their third year, students are encouraged to then apply for the master's program.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Small cohorts of no more than 20 students
- A 24-month program spread over 6 continuous semesters
- Final semesters are immersive clinical rotations with athletic programs, military installations, performing art programs, sports medicine clinics and more.
- Students will have the option to create a research project or prepare a thesis to graduate.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

During their third year, students will apply for the master's program. To be considered, applicants must meet minimum requirements including:

- 3.25 minimum GPA
- 25 verified hours of observation of a certified/licensed athletic trainer
- 3 letters of recommendation
- Verified completion of the prerequisite courses
