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Read and Write is a top-notch Text-To-Speech software that also offers many study tools. It works with both PC and Mac, and is free for KSU students. It's an extremely versatile and adjustable reader.

IPAD SPEAK SELECTION

If you are an iPad user, you can listen to text.

- > Open **settings**.
- > In the "General" tab, select "Accessibility." You will need to scroll down to see it on the right.
- Select the option "Speak Selection." Turn it on and adjust the speaking rate.
- > Touch text for a couple of seconds and a selection box will appear. Select the text and touch "Speak."
- Note: Speak does not work with PDF files. You will need to use another reader for this format. Voice Dream is a great app for reading PDF files.

MAC OS X READER

If you are a Mac user, you do not need to install a reader. A text-to-speech reader is built into the operating system.

- > Open system preferences.
- Select "Dictation & Speech."
- Select "text-to-speech."
- > Select your "system voice." **Text Help Jane** or **Alex** is recommended.
- The default keyboard shortcut is **Option + Esc**. You can change the keyboard shortcut if desired. The same shortcut will stop the text-to-speech feature.
