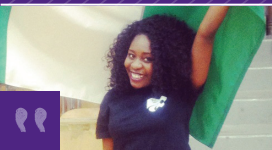

Your eligibility for general university international scholarships will be reviewed based on your application for admission. These scholarships are awarded based on merit and demonstrated achievement.

Apply by the priority date that corresponds with your entry term for maximum award potential:

- Spring – **Nov. 1**
- Fall – **Feb. 1**

GENERAL UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are renewable for up to four years* as long as you meet general renewal requirements. You may only earn one general university scholarship.

International Freshman General University Scholarships		
Scholarship	Value	GPA Requirement
Kansas State International Excellence Award	\$8,000 annually \$32,000 total	Minimum 3.75-4.00 GPA
Kansas State International Distinction Award	\$6,000 annually \$24,000 total	Minimum 3.50-3.74 GPA
Kansas State International Achievement Award	\$4,000 annually \$16,000 total	Minimum 3.20-3.49 GPA
Kansas State International Merit Award	\$2,000 annually \$8,000 total	Minimum 3.10-3.19 GPA

* If you are enrolled in a five-year program in the College of Architecture, Planning & Design, you are able to renew awards for up to four additional years (five years, 10 semesters total).

TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are renewable for up to three years as long as you meet general renewal requirements. You may only earn one general university scholarship.

Kansas State International Esteemed Transfer Award	\$5,000 annually \$15,000 total	Minimum 3.50-4.00 GPA
Kansas State International Notable Transfer Award	\$2,500 annually \$7,500 total	Minimum 3.25-3.49 GPA

FRESHMEN

Priority application dates:

Apply by **Dec. 1** for spring

Apply by **Feb. 1** for summer/fall

Secondary or high school GPA: **2.5+**

TRANSFER

Priority application dates:

Apply by **Dec. 1** for spring

Apply by **Feb. 1** for summer/fall

College GPA on 24+ credit hours
of coursework: **2.0+**

* Some academic programs also have additional admission requirements. If you have less than 24 transferrable credit hours, you must also meet freshman admission requirements.

KNOW THE ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR PROGRAM

Proof of English proficiency is not required for admission to most K-State undergraduate degree programs. However, a few selective programs have different standards.
