

2020 AFFIDAVIT OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR UNDERGRADUATE APPLICANTS

Applicants who need a Form I-20 (F-1) or DS-2019 (J-1) must provide financial documentation (dated within 1 year) to prove that he/she has sufficient funding to cover his/her expenses equal or greater than the estimated minimum yearly cost for an I-20 or estimated minimum cost for the entire period of study for a DS-2019.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT GUIDE

The sponsor must submit official bank documents to show that funding for the total expenses, including any dependent expenses, are available to the student. The amount of funding must include tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, medical insurance, and other expenses. Mandatory health insurance costs are included within the living expenses. Kansas State University assigns tuition & fees on a per credit hour basis. (Individual student needs may vary.) Tuition estimates are for the minimum number of required hours for each classification. Also included in the tuition & fees is the \$200/semester International Student Fee. Students may also be assessed special fees based on the courses he/she chooses to enroll. To review the comprehensive fee schedule please see details at <http://www.k-state.edu/pay>. Students and their sponsors should expect a 5 to 10 percent increase in both tuition and cost of living for each year in attendance.

One of the following would be acceptable documentation:

- **Bank statement** from checking, savings, stock holdings, or deposit accounts
- **Bank letter, on bank letterhead**, showing the date the account opened, average balance, and current balance
- **Scholarship or sponsorship letter** verifying amount, source, dates of award, and approved program of study

Bank documents must be:

1. Translated into English
2. Less than 12 months old
3. Include type of currency
4. Equal to or greater than the total expenses shown below
5. Include account holder's full name that matches the name completed on the Affidavit of Support

COST OF ATTENDANCE — Fall & Spring Semesters

Estimated expenses for two semesters (one academic year) of study for international undergraduates are shown below. These estimated expenses are subject to change and are updated annually based on cost of living (including health insurance) and tuition increases. Expenses are provided for the purpose of sponsorship and for issuing the I-20 or DS-2019. Tuition and fees are estimated using **12 credit hours** per semester for academic classes and **18 credit hours** per semester for English Language Program classes.

*Students are only eligible for resident tuition rates if they are attending as part of a special university agreement .

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COST OF ATTENDANCE — Summer Semester

If summer will be your first semester at Kansas State University, **you must enroll full-time in classes: 9 credit hours** for undergraduate students, **18 credit hours** for English Language Program students.

NOTE: If you begin in Summer, add the Summer total expenses to the Fall & Spring total expenses for your total yearly cost. This total yearly amount must be shown in the bank document.

DEPENDENT COSTS

Estimated living expenses for dependents are \$7,200 per year for the first dependent and \$5,200 per year for each additional dependent. These amounts must be added to your total expenses.
