
Dear President Wefald:

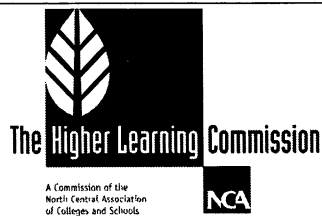
