










Percentage of respondents reporting participation in research by Gender



Percentage of respondents reporting participation in research by Ethnicity/Race





Number of semesters repondents reported research activity by Gender




Number of semesters repondents reported research activity by Ethnicity/Race




Percentage of respondents reporting research contributed to academic success by College



Percentage of respondents reporting research contributed to academic success by Gender




Percentage of respondents reporting research contributed to academic success by Ethnicity/Race









Percentage of respondents reporting contribution of mentor by College






Percentage of respondents reporting contribution of mentor by Ethnicity/Race






Percentage of respondents reporting research contributed to career choices by College



Percentage of respondents reporting research contributed to career choices by Gender




Percentage of respondents reporting research contributed to career choices by Ethnicity/Race






Percentage of respondents reporting research contributes to current success by College
