




Percent of respondents' who participated in research/creative endeavors:








Did respondents feel their research/creative endeavor contribute to their career/graduate school choices?




Reflecting upon your undergraduate experience, do you believe K-State should have provided less, the same, or more opportunities to be involved in the following?






To what extent has each of the following K-State 8 (general education) areas contributed to your understanding of your profession and/or the world around you?



Looking back, do you believe K-State should have placed less, the same, or more emphasis on the following undergraduate learning outcomes?








Respondents' rating of quality of their undergraduate preparation for graduate or professional education:











Degree of difficulty in finding employment:




Minor/secondary major gave respondents an advantage when seeking employment:





Job related to respondents undergraduate field of study:




