Dear Leadership and Auxiliary Camp Participants,

The 2022 Leadership and Auxiliary Camp is quickly approaching! The camp staff has been working very hard to provide you the best experience possible for everyone attending; we cannot wait to get started! Here are some reminders for you as you prepare for camp:

1. Detailed Camp Schedule: This schedule provides a more thorough view of camp activities. A final version will be given to campers when they register in McCain on Sunday from 1:30-3:00pm.

4. Camp Picture Order Form: If you would like to purchase a camp photo, please complete this form and bring it (along with your payment) to Registration on Sunday.

  - b. Orders made by July 11 will be sent home with their camper on 13<sup>th</sup>!
5. Campus Map: This map will help you navigate campus once you arrive!
6. Payment: If you have not mailed in your check (written to KSU Bands) to pay for camp, please do so. We accept checks, money orders, or exact cash. Payment and/or hard copy medical forms can be mailed to:

A few other reminders for you:

1. Dorm Registration/Move-In will occur at the northwest corner of Kramer Dining Hall ('orange star' on the attached map) for resident campers on June 10<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm. Once checked-in with the K-State Housing and Dining Staff, resident campers will move into their dorms at Wefald Hall (the newest dorm on campus)! Resident campers must check-in at the dorms before going through Camp Registration.
2. Camp Registration begins at 1:30pm in Room 201 within McCain Auditorium.
  - a. This is on the Music Department side of McCain Auditorium, enter through the Loading Dock Doors ('red star' on the attached map).
  - b. This will be your chance to check-in, get your camp t-shirt, complete medical forms, make payment if you have not already, and order a camp photo.
3. There will be an All-Camp Meeting on Sunday at 3:00pm in All-Faiths Chapel.
  - a. Campers should be checked-in by this time, parents are welcome to attend this meeting (but are not required).

4. No one will need to bring their instruments/silks to camp!
  - a. Drum Majors, please bring your scores for this season's show, any score marking materials you use, batons if you use them, and a spiral notebook to journal in.
  - b. Percussionists will only need to bring your sticks/mallets! We will provide all instruments for you.
    - i. Please bring a drum pad if you have one too!!!
  - c. Color Guard equipment will be provided, you do not need to bring your own equipment to camp!
5. Campers will be staying in Wefald Hall (K-State's newest dorm) and eating in the Kramer Dining Center! This will mean a lot of walking and punctuality to remain on schedule. Please be prepared for a lot of walking.
6. We will be having a camp pizza dinner on Sunday after auditions!
  - a. If your camper has special medical needs or dietary requirements, make sure you have indicated that in your registration or call us at the band office at 785-532-3816 by Friday morning (July 8<sup>th</sup>) so we can make arrangements.
7. Campers who are parking on-campus must purchase a parking pass to park their vehicle in the "A2 Lot" indicated on the Campus Map; vehicles without a parking pass will be ticketed by K-State Parking Services (including on Wednesday afternoon for the Final Performance).
  - a. Resident Campers with a parking pass are not permitted to drive themselves to/from camp activities for liability purposes.
8. The Non-Resident drop-off/pick-up location is north of All-Faiths Chapel ('blue star' on the attached map). Specific instructions will be given to these campers by their Troop Leaders on Sunday, June 10<sup>th</sup> after dinner.
9. Weather: Warm temperatures are projected for the week of camp (upper 90's and above). Please comb through the schedule, anticipate events, and pack/plan accordingly for heat and the possibility of rain. **There will be a lot of walking. Everyone needs to bring a labeled water bottle with them, comfortable clothes for being outside, sunscreen/aloë, a hat, and anything else you might need to be walking/being outside in the heat (band aides, creams for skin irritations caused by walking, etc.).**
10. The use of Link Scooters is not allowed for liability purpose.
11. On Tuesday, July 12<sup>th</sup>, we will be attending 7:30pm Manhattan Municipal Band Concert at the Larry Norvell Band Shell in City Park (right next to the Wefald Pavilion). Parents are welcome to attend, parking is first come, first serve and the address is below:

12. We will be going to the Manhattan City Pool on Tuesday, July 12<sup>th</sup>! Please plan accordingly with appropriate swimwear, pool towels, sandals, and plenty of sunscreen!
13. Do not forget comfortable camp/walking clothes, toiletries, soap, band aides, sunscreen/aloë, labeled water bottle, and a hat!
14. You are welcome to help you child check out of Wefald Hall at 1:00 pm on Wednesday, July 13<sup>th</sup>. If you cannot be there at 1:00pm to help, that is fine, we will store camper luggage in McCain 201.
  - a. All campers must remain on campus for liability purposes, campers are not allowed to leave to eat lunch with family on Wednesday.
  - b. Campers will walk to McCain at 2:00pm.

- c. You should pick-up your child after the Final Performance in All-Faiths Chapel, the concert should be finished by 5:00pm on Wednesday, June 13<sup>th</sup>.
- d. If your child's luggage is still stored in McCain 201 after the Final Performance, please do not forget to come back to McCain 201 to pick that up.
- e. We ask that you park in the registration parking lot as indicated on the map to pick up luggage; please do not clog up the McCain Circle Drive with traffic.

15. The Final Camp performance will be in All-Faiths Chapel. Paid parking will be available in the parking garage on Anderson. K-State Parking Services will be ticketing on-campus parking lots until 5:00pm.
