

### WHAT TO BRING:

- Bring casual hot weather clothes. Shoes must be worn at all times, no sandals during sessions.
- Drum Majors and Section Leaders: Do not bring your instruments.
- Color Guard: Do not bring your silks.
- Percussion should bring their marching sticks and mallets.
- Conducting baton for Drum Major Candidates (optional).
- Bring spending money.
- Bring washcloth, soap, toiletries, etc...(resident campers only).
- Bring a swimming suit and pool towel. We will be spending an afternoon at the City Pool.

### WE PROVIDE:

- Bed linens, towels, pillow, etc...

### **GENERAL RULES:**

- All camp activities are required, attendance will be taken at every event/transition.
- No visitors are permitted during camp (with the exception of immediate family members in the case of an emergency).
- Inappropriate language (discriminator, derogatory, anti-sematic, etc...), violent behavior, and disrespectful conduct will not be tolerated. Campers will be sent home at their own expense.
- Electronic devices (cell phones, tablets) are not permitted during official camp activities. They will be removed from campers if they are not being used for emergencies.
- Parents of Resident Campers: Please prepare your camper about the possibility of homesickness.
- No refunds will be issued for campers who leave campus after the beginning of camp.
- No campers are permitted to use or possess tobacco, vaping devices, electronic cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, or unauthorized drugs.
- Students are not permitted to drive themselves once they check-in to camp. Everyone will walk together to/from all camp activities (includes the use of scooters, bicycles, etc...).
- Students must always wear their badges.
- Students will be required to pay for lost dorm keys and/or meal cards through K-State Housing and Dining. Our camp staff cannot do anything if these items are lost, it must be handled through K-State Housing and Dining.

- Non-Resident campers will promptly check-in with their Troop Leaders at their designated locations; no exceptions.
- Meals All meals are served in the Kramer Hall Dining Hall. You must eat at your assigned times. You must wear your badge to meals (seconds are allowed). Non-Resident Campers may purchase individual meals by paying for them upon entering the dining hall. Unfortunately, parents will not be allowed to eat with campers during camp.
- Report all illnesses or accidents to the nearest staff member immediately. Camp Staff will be in the Camp Office (226 McCain) during the day. The telephone number is (785) 532-3816.
- Campers must not leave their rooms after lights out! Out of respect for other campers privacy, do not enter someone else's room.
- Students are not allowed in their residence hall room during the day.
- No playing of instruments outside of designated performance areas (no playing in the dorms).
- RECREATION areas are available at the City Park Pool, the Lobby of Wefald Hall, and the KSU Union!
- Any damage to college property due to vandalism or misuse will be charged to the parent of the student involved. Violators of camp rules will be dismissed from camp with no refund of fees. PARENTS MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR IMMEDIATE TRANSPORTATION FOR ANY STUDENT DISMISSED FROM CAMP. Kansas State University assumes no responsibility for the safety of individuals' instruments.
