5. Campus Map: This map will help you navigate campus once you arrive!

A few other reminders for you:

1. Dorm Registration/Move-In will occur at the northwest corner of Kramer Dining Hall ('orange star' on the attached map) for resident campers on June 12th at 1:00pm. Once checked-in with the K-State Housing and Dining Staff, resident campers will move into their dorms at Wefald Hall (the newest dorm on campus)! Resident campers must check-in at the dorms before going through Camp Registration.
2. Camp Registration begins at 1:30pm in Kirmser Hall within McCain Auditorium.
 - a. This is on the Music Department side of McCain Auditorium, enter through the Loading Dock Doors ('red star' on the attached map).
 - b. This will be your chance to check-in, get your camp t-shirt, complete medical forms, make payment if you have not already, and order a camp photo.
3. There will be an All-Camp Meeting on Sunday at 2:45pm in All-Faiths Chapel.
 - a. Campers should be checked-in by this time, parents are welcome to attend this meeting (but are not

required).

4. Percussionists: You will only need to bring your mallets/mallet bags! We will provide all instruments for you.
5. Auditions/Chair Placements: Auditions will consist of simple major scales (to check tone and range) and sight-reading. Campers do not have to have any music prepared ahead of time and are designed to be very low stress. Auditions/Chair Placements will take place right after the Camp Meeting on Sunday.
6. The Non-Resident drop-off/pick-up location is north of All-Faiths Chapel ('blue star' on the attached map). Specific instructions will be given to these campers by their Troop Leaders on Sunday after dinner.
7. Due to room constraints and other variables not in our control, there will be no Jazz Bands at camp for the foreseeable future.
 - a. However, we will have exclusive Music Fundamentals and Chamber Music times to help everyone improve on their instruments like we did at camp last year!
8. We will be having a camp pizza dinner on Sunday after auditions!
 - a. If your camper has special medical needs or dietary requirements, make sure you have indicated that in your registration or call us at the band office at 785-532-3816 by Friday morning (June 10th) so we can make arrangements.
9. Be prepared for a lot of walking. Know the schedule and play close attention to staff instructions so everyone can safely and efficiently transition within the schedule.
10. The Music Camp will not be performing with the Manhattan Municipal Band this year, but they will be attending their concert! This Tuesday, 7:30pm concert will be at the Larry Norvell Band Shell in City Park (right next to the Wefald Pavilion). Parents/families are invited to attend as well. Parking is first come, first serve and the address is below:
