

30th ANNUAL SUMMER KSU MUSIC CAMP

WHAT TO BRING:

- ♪ Bring your INSTRUMENT and case (with camper's name on the case).
- ♪ Percussionists only need to bring their stick bags (with whatever mallets they own). All other instruments will be provided!
- ♪ Concert attire will be the provided Camp T-Shirt, appropriate shorts (khaki), and tennis shoes.
- ♪ Re-useable water bottle (with camper's name on it).
- ♪ Bring casual hot weather clothes; shoes must be always worn. Include *a swimsuit and pool towel*.
- ♪ Bring spending money for extra snacks in the Union. Vending machines and places to purchase snacks in the dorms are limited due to the summer schedule.
- ♪ If you desire, (not required) bring your solos with accompaniment to camp for the Talent Show.

WE PROVIDE:

- ♪ Bed linens, towels, pillow, etc.
- ♪ Everything needed for rehearsals, sectionals, and recreation.
- ♪ Great teachers and great fun!

GENERAL RULES:

- ♪ All camp activities are required, attendance will be taken at every event/transition.
- ♪ No visitors are permitted during camp (with the exception of immediate family members in the case of an emergency).
- ♪ Inappropriate language (discriminator, derogatory, anti-semitic, etc...), violent behavior, and disrespectful conduct will not be tolerated. Campers will be sent home at their own expense.
- ♪ Electronic devices (cell phones, tablets) are not permitted during musical performance activity. They will be removed from campers if they are not being used for emergencies.
- ♪ **Parents of Resident Campers: Please prepare your camper about the possibility of homesickness.**
- ♪ No refunds will be issued for campers who leave campus after the beginning of camp.
- ♪ No campers are permitted to use or possess tobacco, vaping devices, electronic cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, or un-authorized drugs.
- ♪ Students must always wear their badges. If you lose your badge, please report to the Camp Office (226 McCain).
- ♪ Non-Resident campers will promptly check-in with their Troop Leaders at their designated locations; no exceptions.

- ♪ Meals – All meals are served in the Kramer Hall Dining Hall. You must eat at your assigned times. You must wear your badge to meals (seconds are allowed). Non-Resident Campers may purchase individual meals by paying for them upon entering the dining hall. Unfortunately parents will not be allowed to eat with campers on Thursday evening.
- ♪ Report all illnesses or accidents to the nearest staff member immediately. Camp Staff will be in the Camp Office (226 McCain) during the day. The telephone number is (785) 532-3816.
- ♪ Campers must not leave their rooms after lights out! Out of respect for other campers privacy, do not enter someone else's room.
- ♪ Students are not allowed in their residence hall room during the day.
- ♪ No playing of instruments outside of designated performance areas (no playing in the dorms).
- ♪ You may bring money to purchase K-State items in the Student Union Bookstore.
- ♪ RECREATION areas are available in the Student Union building and the City Park Pool!
- ♪ Any damage to college property due to vandalism or misuse will be charged to the parent of the student involved. Violators of camp rules will be dismissed from camp with no refund of fees. PARENTS MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR IMMEDIATE TRANSPORTATION FOR ANY STUDENT DISMISSED FROM CAMP. Kansas State University assumes no responsibility for the safety of individuals' instruments.
