- 3 A letter of intent written by the applicant 1-2 pages in length. # **IN-PERSON / ON-CAMPUS AUDITIONS 2023:**

Saturday April 22nd, 2023

### In Person Auditions will consist of:

- Short routine involving fundamental movements typically performed by the K-State Color guard (taught at the audition).
- 6-fundamental tosses (taught at the audition, but can be found on our youtube page and practiced ahead of time).
  - Parallel Toss
  - Single (right) Toss
  - o J Toss
  - Money Hand Toss
  - Double Fast Toss
  - 45 Toss
- Low step marching fundamentals (taught at the audition, but can be found on our youtube page and practiced ahead of time).

### **Audition Attire:**

Please wear professional clothing that allows for movement and physical activity, as well as appropriate footwear (i.e. no jean shorts, sandals, boots, oversized sweats, etc.). Members should look professional and ready to perform.

### **Equipment:**

All auditions must be completed with a 6-foot pole that is provided by Kansas State University. This flag will be weighted on both ends.

# Timeline of Audition day:

- 11:30am Registration and stretching
- 12:00pm Begin learning audition routine
- 1:30pm Learn fundamental tossing and marching
- 2:00pm Practice and review
- 2:30pm Auditions begin in groups in front of a panel of judges
- Once auditions have been scored the 23-24 team will be announced and there will be a brief meeting for all team members.
