## Talking points for Administrators/Faculty Staff/Students

## Purpose of the iSIS Upgrade

- Provides improve features that faculty, staff and administrators have been requesting including the improved navigation
- Keep all financial aid components up to date with federal requirements (which change every year)
- Upgrade to version 9
- This will be the last time that an upgrade of this magnitude occurs to the iSIS system for several years, subsequent upgrades will occur in smaller bundles (and/or as new features are made available)

#### What new features will be available to K-Staters?

- A new iSIS home page
- Improved navigational capabilities
- Improved access to advising information

## Why is this occurring in November?

- Classes will not be in session during Thanksgiving week
- Lower demand on business operations for business offices, e.g., Admissions, Financial Assistance, Registrar, etc.
- Higher demand for business operations occurs at the end of the fall and beginning of the spring semesters
- Provides foundation for future enhancements to iSIS soon after the upgrade.

#### What is the impact of the November timeframe upgrade?

- Students will enroll in the current iSIS up to the Friday before Thanksgiving (Nov. 19). Enrollment will not be available again until after the upgrade.
- Advisors will use the current advising process in the current iSIS up to the Friday before Thanksgiving (Nov. 19). iSIS will not be available again until after the upgrade. Advisors can take advantage of the improved Advisor Center after the upgrade.
- Faculty will perform all grading for classes after Nov. 24 in the upgraded iSIS.

#### What is the proposed timeframe? Friday, Nov 19 at 5 pm through Wednesday, Nov 24.

• If the upgrade is completed earlier than Wednesday, iSIS will be brought up sooner.

Users under personalizations will have the option to turn that back on.
- Most processes within iSIS will remain unchanged. Significant process changes will be documented and communicated through the functional offices responsible for those changes.

## What will be available/unavailable, etc during the upgrade period

- Access academic information contained in other systems, e.g., K-State Online, Online Course Catalog (Acalog), etc.
- Re-run a previous degree audit/DARS report from K-State Online.

#### 2. Unavailable

- View student information, e.g., admissions, milestone information, student account information, service indicators, etc.
- View course information, e.g., class rosters, schedules, etc.
- Run a degree audit/DARS report from iSIS
- View or post grades

#### 3. Other pertinent information

 Posting of academic information in iSIS, e.g., admissions, milestone information, student account information, will be held in a queue and processed immediately after the upgrade is complete.

## What will be available/unavailable, etc during the upgrade period?

#### 1. Available

- Apply for admissions, scholarships, and financial aid via the web.
- Mail or fax items to the offices of Admissions, Registrar, Financial Assistance, Division of Financial Affairs, and Graduate School.
- Make payment(s) to their student account through the CASHNet website and in person at the Cashier's Office.
- View open versus closed status of classes through course listing

#### 2. Unavailable

- Access Student Center/Self-Service.
- Enroll or access their class schedule.
- · Accept or reject financial aid.
- Make payment(s) to their student account within Isis.
- Run a degree audit/DARS report from iSIS.

## 3. Other pertinent information that will be processed after the upgrade

- Applications for admissions, scholarships, and financial aid
- Entry of transcript information and test scores in iSIS Processing of transcript requests, updating of academic records, and production of related reports will be addressed
- Financial aid disbursements
- Any payments made during the upgrade will be posted to student accounts in iSIS

## Changes/New Features

- Swap classes during enrollment
- Review Majors/Minors
- Review entire Course History at K-State

#### **Business Offices**

While iSIS is being upgraded and not available, the following tasks  $\underline{can/will}$  be performed during the upgrade:

- Receive applications for admissions, scholarships, and financial aid submitted via the web, mail, or fax.
- Access current student account balances in CASHNet, and student account balances in iSIS as of 5 pm. Friday, November 19th.
- Receive requests for transcripts, updates, and reports.
- Project Team members will have access to a copy of iSIS data as of Friday, November 19th should it be needed for emergency or other purposes.

# While iSIS is being upgraded and not available, the following tasks $\frac{\text{cannot/will not}}{\text{performed until after the upgrade is finished:}}$

- Process admissions, scholarship, and financial aid applications.
- Award, disburse, or make adjustments to students' financial aid and loans.
- Post payments to student accounts in iSIS.
- Issue I-20 visa documents for international students.
- Enter high school or transfer credit transcript information and test scores.
- Generate transcripts.
- Update or correct student information in iSIS.
- Post student programs of study, and doctoral preliminary and final examination information.
- Produce reports, e.g., admissions status, milestone information, student account information, service indicator information, etc.
- Correct enrollments with Enrollment Services, e.g., undergraduate and graduate level credits.

\*\*Production system will be cloned on Friday, November 19. Only designated personnel will have access to a read only view of iSIS. There will be no ability to edit or change aspects of the cloned system. The need for access needs to closely manage so the team can perform the upgrade.

There will be no read only access for students during the upgrade.
