- Go to **K-State Core Alignment Templates**
- Select **Academic Degree Map**

Build Curriculum Plan

Step 1: **View Curriculum Courses** tab

- displays all courses currently available in the program
- K-State Core general education courses are displayed by default
- import courses needed to build the program
- see [help](#) for more information

Step 2: **View Curriculum Schema** tab

- displays requirements template
- K-State Core requirements and course lists are automatically included in template: DO NOT MODIFY
- shells are provided for program and major requirements
- click on a requirement to expand the entry area
- replace "Title1" with appropriate requirement name
- replace "X" Credit Hours with total credits for that requirement
- add courses to each requirement
- see [help](#) for more information

Step 3: **Curriculum Preview** button

- displays the catalog view of the program
- to make edits go back to **View Curriculum Schema**
- make sure that ALL credit hours add up to the appropriate total
