Next-Gen K-State progress update

Campus Master Plan and infrastructure

- Campus Master Plan unveiling in fall 2025, integrating all three campuses
- \$128 million deferred maintenance eliminated since fiscal year 2023; Over \$100 million new investment planned for FY 2025-2026
- 43% of <u>targeted classroom modernizations</u> completed

Workforce and systems

- New Compensation Study and Career Architecture Development initiative launched
- Building Next-Gen Leadership series continuing after engaging 1,300+ employees
- New <u>Performance Management</u> process implemented with new <u>Electronic Learning</u>
 <u>System</u> coming soon
- Single <u>time and leave system</u> launching this fall

Safety and security

- K-State Alerts system overhaul and new K-State Safe mobile app launching
- Expanded camera system across campuses (165 total)
- New unified badge reader access system being implemented
- Enhanced email security blocked over 4.9 million harmful messages in April
