




### **Prosperity Pillar Report (Kansas Board of Regents)**

In fiscal year 2025, Kansas State University reported:

- 737 direct jobs created or retained
- \$21.5 million in direct investment attracted
- \$279.7 million in research and grant expenditures
- 74 companies or business ventures created
- \$1.4 million in foreign direct investment
- \$1.0 million in harvested equity
- \$112.6 million in philanthropy aligned to framework initiatives

### **K-State's leadership in rural health**

Through the [Rural Health Transformation Program](#), K-State serves as a collaborating partner on an unprecedented federal investment in rural health to strengthen sustainable access to care and improve health outcomes.
