While we were hoping to completely fund this trip for students, we may require that some expenses may be paid by the individual student. Therefore, if you are approved for this trip, you will be expected to book your own travel as we return from Washington D.C. to Kansas City on Tuesday, November 8. Currently these flights are \$99. It is possible we may also ask you to pay for your flight to DC on November 6 (\$139) but I am hopeful we can avoid that.

You will be asked to share a hotel room with another student of the same gender, and it is possible we may have three people in a hotel room. Again, the club will pay for your shuttle travel and hotel. Leisure travel is the responsibility of each student. We may be driving to Kansas City on the evening of Saturday, November 5, whether we fly out Sunday morning or afternoon, the club will be covering all hotel room costs.

MANY OF OUR HOSTS REQUIRE PROOF OF COVID-19 VACCINATION TO ENTER THEIR OFFICES. THEREFORE, I AM GOING TO REQUEST THAT STUDENTS COMMIT TO BEING ABLE TO PROVIDE PROOF OF VACCINATION IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE ON THIS TRIP.

The current plan is to fly out of Kansas City at 840 AM arriving in Washington DC at 1155 AM. We will take a shuttle to the hotel and have a group dinner. On Tuesday, most students will return to Kansas City on a 415 PM flight arriving at 610 PM.
