Assumptions of the Manufacturing Sector

- 1. Manufacturing firms assemble bikes using land, labor, and imported parts.
- 2. All the bikes are exported to other regions.
- 3. Imported parts and finished bikes are transported by trucks on a highway running through the city.
- 4. Price of bikes is fixed.
- 5. Each manufacturing firm produces 5 bikes at a price of \$50 per bike.
- 6. Each manufacturing firm occupies a 2 acre site.
- 7. Freight cost per bike per mile is \$4.
