Government Promotion Facts

- 1. Total government spending for transportation facilities and services increased from \$3.7 billion in 1947 to over \$200 billion today.
- 2. State and local government spends more than twice as much money as the federal government on transportation facilities and services.
- 3. Highway spending accounts for about 60 percent of total government spending on transportation facilities and services.
- 4. State and local government spends nearly three times as much money on highways as the federal government.
- 5. The airway system is entirely the federal government's financial responsibility.
- 6. State and local government spends nearly five times as much as the federal government on airports.
