Trends in Intercity Freight Modal Market Shares Ton-Miles

- 1. Railroads have the largest share of the market when the market is measured by ton-miles. Trucks have the largest share when the market is measured by tons. This is because railroads have a higher average length of haul than trucks.
- 2. Since 1990, the railroad share of the market has risen from 31.9 percent to 40 percent.
- 3. Between 1990 and 2009, the truck share of the market increased from 25.4 percent to 33.4 percent.
- 4. Between 1990 and 2009, the oil pipeline share of the market dropped from 17.5 percent to 14.3 percent.
- 5. Between 1990 and 2009, the waterway carriers share of the market fell from 24.9 percent to 12 percent.
- 6. The air carrier share of the market is very small.
